Let's face it, the idea of never having to shave again is like going to your dentist only to have them tell you, that you never need to come back. Shaving, tweezing and waxing are all time consuming, not to mention only a short term solution. The idea of laser hair removal is great, but the fear of the unknown can be an intimidating thing. Does It Work? How laser hair removal works is through highly controlled pulses of intense light which are absorbed by the hair follicles lying below the surface of the skin. The absorbed light heats and destroys the hair follicle preventing regrowth from occurring, and without damaging surrounding tissues.

Does It Hurt? The procedure does come with some mild discomfort but nothing debilatating. Put it this way, most people stop in to do their treatments in-between running errands or on their lunch break, there is no down time involved. The sensation experienced during treatment is most often compared to a stinging, like that of a rubber band snapping against your skin. What you're feeling is the laser zapping the hair follicule, this sensation only lasts about a millisecond.

How Many Treatments Will I Need? The number of treatments you will need depends on differ-

ent factors, but typically you will need a minimum of six treatments. This can vary depending on hair density, colour, area, etc. During their life cycle, your hair goes through three different stages at different periods of time. Your hair is most vulnerable to laser during a specific stage, which is why several treatments are required.

What Is The Cost? This is dependant on the area, but prices can range anywhere from \$29 to \$279 per treatment. Generally smaller areas such as chin, eyebrows, upper lip are starting at the lower end. Whereas areas that cover more surface, such as legs, will be higher in price due to time involved. After your first six treatments you will be given a maintenace discount determined by your laser technician.

Is It Permanent? This is probably one of the biggest misconceptions with laser hair removal. Laser hair removal is permanent hair reduction, not permanent hair removal. It is not uncommon for clients to require periodic maintenance after treatment is completed. The reason is that the laser targets your current hair follicules, but new follicles can develop over time due to hormonal changes or other factors.

This can be seen in the fact treatments use to be days or sometimes weeks of downtime, whereas now we are pretty much bruise free and any side effects have been reduced to a minimum.

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
WHO WE ARE: WINDSOR - ROSELAND ROTARY CLUB
